

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. \_\_\_\_\_**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. WATSON COLEMAN OF NEW**  
**JERSEY**

Redesignate section 8 as section 9.

Insert after section 7 the following:

**1 SEC. 8. CYBERSECURITY AWARENESS CAMPAIGN.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subtitle C of title II of the Home-  
3 land Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 141 et seq.) is amend-  
4 ed by adding at the end the following:

**5 “SEC. 230. CYBERSECURITY AWARENESS CAMPAIGN.**

6 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Under Secretary for  
7 Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Protection shall develop  
8 and implement an ongoing and comprehensive  
9 cybersecurity awareness campaign regarding cybersecurity  
10 risks and voluntary best practices for mitigating and re-  
11 sponding to such risks. Such campaign shall, at a min-  
12 imum, publish and disseminate, on an ongoing basis, the  
13 following:

14 “(1) Public service announcements targeted at  
15 improving awareness among State, local, and tribal  
16 governments, the private sector, academia, and  
17 stakeholders in specific audiences, including the el-

1 derly, students, small businesses, members of the  
2 Armed Forces, and veterans.

3 “(2) Vendor and technology-neutral voluntary  
4 best practices information.

5 “(b) CONSULTATION.—The Under Secretary for  
6 Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Protection shall consult  
7 with a wide range of stakeholders in government, industry,  
8 academia, and the non-profit community in carrying out  
9 this section.”.

10 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents  
11 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is amended by in-  
12 serting after the item relating to section 226 (relating to  
13 cybersecurity recruitment and retention) the following new  
14 item:

“Sec. 230. Cybersecurity awareness campaign.”.
